



PARENT/GUARDIAN PERMISSION + STUDENT VERIFICATION

One Reel and The City of Seattle in partnership with The Vera Project, EMP Museum, Seattle Office of Arts & Culture and Seattle Office of Film + Music present an exciting one-day educational opportunity for Seattle Public High School students interested in pursuing a career in the music industry. The City of Music Career Day will take place on Wednesday, April 22, 2015 at EMP Museum, Vera Project, and the Seattle Center Armory Lofts located at 325 5th Ave N, Seattle, WA 98109, 305 Warren Ave N, Seattle, WA 98109, and 305 Harrison St, Seattle, WA 98109.

Pre-Registration is required online at <http://careerday.onereel.org>. On-site check-in begins at 8 A.M. inside EMP Museum, followed by programming from 9 A.M. – 2 P.M. which will include: a welcome address, panel sessions with Northwest artists and music industry professionals, a career fair featuring music-focused organizations, and live musical performances. Students check in upon arrival and participate in supervised programming throughout the day. The event is FREE of charge and lunch is included; however, transportation to and from the event is not provided so please make travel arrangements in advance.

In order to request an excused absence for this event, a written request must be submitted to the school at least three days prior to the event, and be approved by the Principal or Assistant Principal. Attendance and participation must be verified on this form and returned to the student's school to qualify for an excused absence.

STEP 1: Have your child register online at careerday.onereel.org.

STEP 2: Submit a written request to your child's school at least three days prior to the event. Identify the "City of Music Career Day" as the reason for the absence.

STEP 3: Sign this form and have your child bring it with them to the event. The Career Day staff will verify their participation at the event on the back of this form.

STEP 4: Have your child return this completed form to their school to qualify for an excused absence.

CONSENT: The Seattle School District wants to notify you that this will not be a Seattle School District supervised event. It is very important that before you allow your child to attend this event that you know that no District or school staff will be at the event to chaperone or supervise your child, nor does the District have any control over what happens at the event. Please factor this in when determining whether your child should attend this event on his or her own. This event is similar to a weekend activity where no supervision is provided by District staff.
